

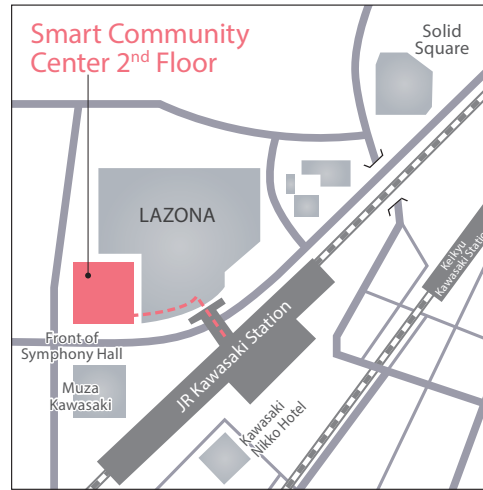

There is no reserved parking lot for museum visitors

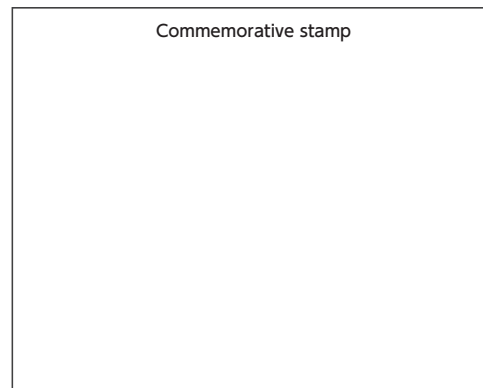
